



Dress Code

To avoid embarrassment or offence Cottrell Park Golf Club requires the following appropriate standard of dress when using the golf course or clubhouse.

1. No denim, tracksuits or trainers may be worn on the courses.
2. Golf shoes must be worn when playing. Spikes of any form are not permitted in the clubhouse.
3. SHIRTS
 - a. Shirts must have sleeves and collars and may not be worn outside trousers.
 - b. Rugby and football type shirts are not allowed.
4. SHORTS
 - a. Shorts must be tailored and knee length.
 - b. Tennis, football, rugby, beach, cropped or combat style shorts may not be worn.
5. SOCKS

Short socks, when worn, must be ankle length and predominantly white.
6. TROUSERS
 - a. Trousers must be tailored.
 - b. No combat style trousers may be worn.
 - c. Trouser bottoms may not be tucked into socks.
7. MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones may not be used on the courses except in an emergency.

We operate a system of Course Marshall's who are empowered to enforce the dress code on the golf course. Failure to meet the dress code standards may result in you being refused use of the golf course or removed from it.

Etiquette

Cottrell Park Golf Club welcomes groups of golfers; to ensure that you have an enjoyable day we would kindly request that you follow the enclosed guidelines when visiting.

Please follow the dress code currently in place at the golf club

All golfers must be able to demonstrate a proficiency in the skills of golf, the club reserves the right to review any individuals ability and if necessary remove the individual from the golf course

Please do not change in the car park use the changing facilities provided

All visitors must register their arrival in the professional shop

Please arrive at the first tee not less than 8 minutes before your appointed tee time

Mobile telephones are not permitted to be used on the golf course except in an emergency. When in the clubhouse please feel free to use your telephone but take other members and guests enjoyment in to consideration

Please repair all pitch marks and divots and when in a bunker please use the rakes provided to repair any footprints and smooth over the sand

Avoid SLOW PLAY at all times, please keep up with the group in front of you and do not loose a hole. Continuous slow play will result in you being asked to leave the course

If you are playing Stableford and you cannot score please pick up to avoid slow play

Please adhere to white lines and traffic control measures on the golf course

Avoid taking trolleys and buggies on to or near tees and greens

Please be advised that taking alcohol or consuming alcohol on the golf course is strictly prohibited

Please avoid the use of loud and abusive language both on the golf course and in the clubhouse

Should you have any concerns when playing the golf course please relay them to the Course Marshal who will be happy to assist you
